A workshop on the West Virginia University campus for teachers of Algebra I Support. Algebra I teachers and collaborative and vertical teams are encouraged and welcome to attend.

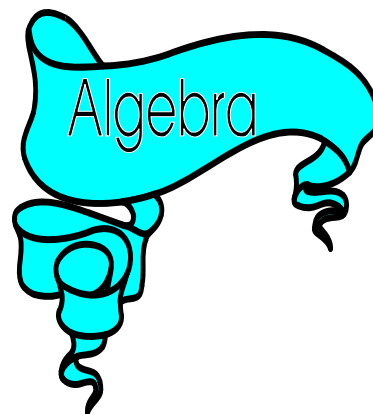
Application deadline: November 18, 2009
